ANDALUSIA

A key region in the aerospace sector

IN 2022, THE AERONAUTICAL SECTOR IN ANDALUSIA GENERATED €2,356 MILLION IN REVENUE WITH AN INCREASE OF 17% OVER THE PREVIOUS YEAR. THIS AMOUNT REPRESENTS APPROXIMATELY 1.24% OF ANDALUSIA'S OVERALL GDP AND A NOTEWORTHY 9.9% OF THE REGION'S INDUSTRIAL GDP.

The anticipation of even higher growth for 2023 indicates new opportunities within the industry.

Andalusia's status as a prominent aerospace hub in Europe is underscored by its 143 aeronautical companies and employment of 13,136 specialists. This concentration of companies and workforce makes Andalusia a significant player in the aerospace industry. Notably, Andalusia stands out as the only region in Spain where the manufacturing and assembly of large planes are accomplished.

One of the key players in Andalusia's aerospace sector is Airbus Group, which is involved in significant projects, particularly in the military transport segment. Airbus Group's activities in the region include the development and operation of final assembly lines for various aircraft models such as the A400M, C235, and C295. These projects contribute substantially to the region's economy and its stature within the European aerospace industry.



Andalusia also hosts major Spanish tier-one suppliers, Aciturri and Aernnova, who provide manufactured components such as aero structures, composite and metallic parts as well as engineering and other services to projects such as the Eurofighter Typhoon or Boeing's B737. They also provide opportunities for the many other aerospace suppliers located in Andalusia.

Andalusia is also one of Europe's leading locations for the development and testing of Unmanned Aerial Systems (UAS). "Atlas", the only UAS Experimental Flight Centre in Spain, is located here and offers a reserved airspace of 35x30 km as well as a main runway of 800 metres that is suitable for light UAVs. The Spanish government has recently chosen Andalusia as the location for "CEUS", Spain's UAS centre of excellence that will also have a runway for heavy UAVs.

With the designation of Seville as the headquarters of the future Spanish Space Agency, it is expected that the space sector will take off in the region. The Andalusian sector, very strong in the aeronautical segment, is committed to strengthening the space segment by taking advantage of synergies with existing technological capabilities.


